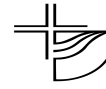

Additional Financial Information:

We need an average of **\$2,450 weekly** or **\$10,600 monthly** to meet *budgeted* 2023 expenses. Our budget shows average inflows of \$2,100 weekly, or \$9,050 monthly, which results in a shortfall to cover budgeted expenses. Our goal of becoming self-sustaining, requires an **additional \$1,150 monthly (\$350 weekly) in average inflows.**
